- Minutes approved – no corrections
- New agenda items
- Discussion of 2010/2011 Camden Public Works budget related to sidewalk maintenance and construction.
 - Storm Drainage is number 1 priority
 - Around Montessori School on Elm/Union would like to put in curb
 - Intersection of Pleasant and Union needs to be fixed up
 - Across Wash St – by the old police station – needs patching – curbing
 - Belmont sidewalk – needs to be redone – but drainage issues around the Belmont Inn
 - Bridges need repair – Molyneaux Road – both of them.
 - Reset curb on Pleasant – coming up from Wood St
 - Sidewalk on Wood St needs to be redone – going over to Elm St
 - In general Public Works focuses on curbing and quality of what's there – not so much with signage
 - Rawson Ave – repaving, depends on funding, so does the sidewalk
- Gateway 1 – after discussion it was voted and agreed that Pathways would propose; in Rockport a pathway up Rte 90 including ped control at Rte 1 up to CHRHS, and in Camden a new Gateway to Camden including a ped connection to the Hannaford Shopping Center and the bus station and a redo of the John/Conway/Camden intersection. **Action – Geoff** to write up and propose at the Planning Board Meeting.
- TIF in Camden - CEDAC Planning Committee – Town is looking for ways to stimulate economy. Create a TIF in downtown. On the 14th all stakeholders need to provide input. What would we want as part of this funding? We will propose funding for the Riverwalk. **Action – Geoff** to write up and propose to be included in TIF.
- Rockport – Proposed Sidewalk projects –
 - Russel Ave – Beauchaump to Calderwood – 1060 feet of sidewalk. \$83K – for project. Blasting ledge and pulling out cedars. Take out existing sidewalk to Janet's property – move it up to road, and landscape for \$28K. **Action - Geoff** to speak to Bob about how the design for this project came to be.
 - 170 Russell to Brooks St – 325 feet of sidewalk – some tar and some tar curb. Two catch basins – will be granite and concrete - \$27K.
