- Geoff reported on the Riverwalk Coalition's work on the old Tannery property. There will be a work day and public input in the next few weeks. All invited to attend both. The Coalition's plan is to work towards a deadline of submitting an MDOT Recreational Trails grand app due Nov 5th.
- Rawson Ave property report was minimal since Wendy wasn't present. Geoff reported Mr. Cotta is out of the country, and Wendy is working on scheduling a walk thru with him and CMLT. As far as we know Mr. Cotta is still interested in pursuing and easement and CMLT is willing to be the holder of that easement.
- Anita will look into options for funding possible property purchases for pathway development. She will speak with bank(s) and CMLT on different options.
- Geoff reported that he had met with MSAD board again regarding a future pathway along CRMS. They affirmed their support and that the pending RSU vote could change the picture. That is, the Town or the RSU could be the new property owners after the vote.
- Anita completed the TEP for extension of sidewalk to Shirttail. Great job. We'll know more in the winter about funding.
