

**Cemetery Association
Minutes of Meeting
May 12, 2010**

The Town of Camden Cemetery Association held a special meeting on the above date. Present were Larry Gross, Jeff Sukeforth, Carole Lerner, Parker Laite, Sr., Isa Babb, Pat Ayers and Chris Lowe. Also attending were Select Board member Deborah Dodge, Parks and Recreation Director Jeff Kuller and Finance Director Carol Sue Greenleaf. The meeting was chaired by Jeff Sukeforth.

1. Mt. View Fence Painting – negotiate bid received on 3/31/2010 – Carol Sue explained that after the last Cemetery meeting held on April 28, 2010 she received a telephone call from David Rice (Mid-Coast Painters). Mr. Rice felt that he could reduce his estimate to paint the Mt. View Cemetery fence if he were allowed to place signs advertising his painting business at the work site. Carol Sue told him she did not see a problem in doing this (as long as his signs were tasteful) and suggested that he put his new figures in writing for the Cemetery Committee to review. After discussion about a few of the painting details Parker Laite, Sr. made a motion, “to approve the negotiated price received from Mid-Coast Painters of \$10,000 as set forth in their paperwork dated 5/4/2010 and to use \$2,000 from the current budget account # 5510-1252 “Capital Improvements/Mt. View Cemetery” with the remaining \$8,000 to come from the Cemetery Reserve account”. The motion was 2nd by Chris Lowe and approved by a vote. In the discussion that followed it was decided that the fence color would be changed to black. Cemetery Sexton Bruce Libby will be asked to supervise the work (and progress) on this painting project.

This special meeting was adjourned at 4:15 P.M.
