- 11) Tour of Camden Wastewater Treatment Plant. Dave Bolstridge gave an informative one-hour tour of the treatment plant on October 2 for Wayne, Sam, Vicki, Roger and Jeannie Hutchins. We learned that the treatment plant has plenty of excess capacity, since it was designed when there was more industry in Camden. The volume of liquid increases significantly during rain events, indicating that storm water is entering the septic system, possibly through basement sump pumps, broken pipes, etc. Much of the infra-structure in the treatment plant does need upgrading.
