OLD BUSINESS:

- The minutes of the meeting held on September 3rd were approved.
- Doug reported that we are awaiting a response from the town as to CCC's request for an increase in monies granted annually from the general account and that the request for monies from the reserve account to be used in connection with the nature walks was on the Select Board's agenda on October 28th.
- Doug read his letter to the editor regarding the Park/Open space non-binding item (referring to the tannery property) on the November 4th ballot. There was some discussion relating to the information on tannery property toxic waste containment, information that Kristen had gathered from the town and sent to CCC members.
- In response to a question from Roger, Doug said that the significant tree walk brochure will be ready by the end of the year.
- Roger volunteered to draft a letter (to the Planning Board and/or Select Board) outlining CCC's position on tree cutting on Ragged Mountain.

Doug noted at the close of the meeting how CCC members were working together on key current issues facing the town.

The next meeting is scheduled for December 3rd at 7 PM.
