

**Cemetery Association
Minutes of Meeting
January 19, 2011**

The Town of Camden Cemetery Association held a meeting on the above date. Present were Jeff Sukeforth, Isa Babb, Pat Ayers, Parker Laite, Sr., Kristine Lerner and Larry Gross. Chris Lowe was absent. Also attending were Select Board member Deborah Dodge, Finance Director Carol Sue Greenleaf and Parks & Recreation Director Jeff Kuller. Jeff Sukeforth chaired the meeting.

1. Approve the minutes of the October 27, 2010 meeting – Parker Laite, Sr. made a motion, “to approve the minutes of the October 27, 2010 meeting as written”. The motion was 2nd by Isa Babb and approved by a vote.
2. Financial reports – Carol Sue reviewed the financial reports with the committee. Isa Babb made a motion, “to approve the financial reports as presented”. The motion was 2nd by Parker Laite, Sr. and approved by a vote.
3. FY 2011-2012 budget – The committee reviewed budget amounts. Jeff Kuller reported that his expense figure for the Town Maintenance Contract line would be \$50,000 or less. The FY 2010-2011 amount was \$56,447. It was noted that investment revenues were reduced by almost \$12,000 (compared with prior year). Parker Laite, Sr. made a motion, “to approve the Cemetery Association FY2011-2012 expense budget of \$76,464 and revenue budget of \$76,729”. The motion was 2nd by Larry Gross and approved by a vote.
4. Proposed By-law changes – Jeff Sukeforth explained his proposal to add additional wording to the Mt. View (ARTICLE 8 & ARTICLE 16) and Oak Hill (ARTICLE 10 & ARTICLE 17) Cemetery By-laws. The additional wording will read (consecutively):

“All flags, if not removed by the owners, will be removed by Cemetery workers after Veterans Day of the calendar year. Flag holders will not be removed. This is to avoid flags being tattered and worn during the winter months”.

“No dogs are allowed in the Town of Camden cemeteries with the exception of certified service animals”.

The next regular meeting was scheduled for April 20, 2011 at 4:00 P.M. in the Washington Street Conference Room. The meeting adjourned at 4:50 P.M.
