

**Cemetery Association
Minutes of Meeting
April 15, 2015**

The Town of Camden Cemetery Association held a meeting on the above date. Present were Jeff Sukeforth, Parker Laite, Sr., Isa Babb, Pat Ayers and Kristine Lerner. Also attending were Sexton Bruce Libby and Finance Director Carol Sue Greenleaf. The meeting was chaired by Jeff Sukeforth.

1. Approve the minutes of the 1/21/2015 meeting – Pat Ayers asked about the use of the word “completed” in item #4 (Financial Reports). Carol Sue clarified that the word was used in referring to the stone restoration work as being completed, but only because the funds for FY 2015 were 100% spent. Parker Laite made a motion, “to approve the minutes of the 1/21/2015 meeting as written”. The motion was 2nd by Pat Ayers and approved by a vote.
2. Tomb repair (update) – Damage to the tomb last year has not been repaired. After a brief conversation Parker Laite made a motion, “to have the proper repairs made to the old doorway and a Bilco entrance door installed”. The motion was 2nd by Isa Babb and approved by a vote. It was agreed that if there are not enough funds in the operating budget to cover costs the reserve account could be used. It is hoped that repairs will be completed by Memorial Day 2015.
3. Mt. View fence (update) – It was noted that no work on the fence had begun as yet this year.
4. Financial reports – Carol Sue reported that expenses are at 87% which is only a 1% difference since January, “not a lot going on during the winter”. The \$600.00 donation to the American Legion for flags and holders has been mailed and will be reflected on next month’s financial reports. She also noted that historically remaining funds in the “Stone Restoration and Tree Maintenance” expense lines are voted to be carried forward at this meeting. This year those funds have been spent and the vote will not be necessary. Parker Laite made a motion, “to approve the financial reports as presented”. The motion was 2nd by Isa Babb and approved by a vote.

OTHER

Bruce Libby noted that the paving around the tomb needs attention. He was asked to obtain estimates. Work could begin (hopefully done before Memorial Day 2015) as soon as possible if estimates are reasonable; with funds being taken from the reserve account. No vote was taken.

Bruce will also investigate having necessary tree work done.

Jeff Sukeforth reported that the Fire Department will be burning along Washington Street as they have done in the past.

The meeting adjourned at 4:30 P.M.
