The following additions are recommended:

- The Opera House is now on the National Historic Register and listed as a building in the great fire historic district.
- The name of the meeting room is the Washington Street Conference Room
- The Camden library and the Amphitheater are now a national landmark
- Harbor Park was designed by Frederick Law Olmstead and the historic restoration of Harbor Park is complete.
- The Elm Street School, which is in the Chestnut Street Historic District, is rented to the Children's House Montessori School.
- Future needs include planting trees at the Mountain View Cemetery
