Town of Camden Select Board Meeting 10 November, 2015

Minutes

Present: Select Board Members, Don White, who chaired the meeting, Leonard Lookner, Martin Cates, James Heard, and Town Manager, Pat Finnigan. Select Board Chair John French, arrived at 7:00 pm. Also present were citizens and a new member of the press, Liz Hebert of the *Camden Herald*.

A. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm.

B. Communications, Presentations, and Recognitions

1) Christmas by the Sea Committee: Presentation and request to close Atlantic Avenue on Dec. 4.

Community Development Director, Karen Brace, along with Christmas by the Sea Committee Members, Patty Siegenthaler, and Cindy Lampley, reported on the schedule for the Event which is taking place on December 4-6, 2015. Karen Brace asked the Select Board to consider closing Atlantic Avenue on Dec. 4, 2015 from 4 to 8 pm. An initial motion was made and Leonard Lookner amended this motion.

Leonard Lookner amended a motion to extend the hours of the Atlantic Avenue closure to be in affect from 3pm until 9 pm on Friday, December 4, 2015. James Heard seconded this and the motion passed 5-0.

2) Ragged Mountain Redevelopment/Snow Bowl Report

Snow Bowl General Manager Landon Fake updated the Select Board regarding preparations for the upcoming ski season. He said season pass sales are strong: up 17% over last year at this time. He reported on the data tracking that is now implemented, the double chairlift is up and awaiting inspection, and the parking lot and storm water management system that performed well after the recent heavy rains. He said the Ski Club's pancake breakfast which was held every Sunday in October, and the chair lift rides had been very popular. Despite the last weekend getting rained out, revenues exceeded the budget. He said the expansion of the free 4th Grade Learn to Ski program may soon include the Towns of Belmont, Searsmont, and Morrill.

B. Citizen Comments (on topics which are not on the agenda)

There were no citizen comments.

C. Approval of Select Board Minutes dated October 27, 2015

James Heard made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Martin Cates seconded this, and the motion carried 5-0.

D. Select Board Member Reports

John French reported that he has been told by several citizens that they were not pleased with the rise in sewer costs. He said that people have to understand that the infrastructure is very old (100 years in some places) and that it needs to be upgraded. He wanted the citizens to know that the Town is doing its best to keep things running.

Leonard Lookner wanted to say Happy Birthday to the United States Marines who have celebrated 240 years in service.

Don White noted that Wednesday November 11th is Veterans Day and asked people to remember the sacrifice veterans have made. He also reported that he has heard concerns from citizens regarding the fact that there are no "ties" in the new solid waste bags. Mr. White then reported on his attendance at the Historic Resources Committee Meeting. He also said that the next meeting of the Tannery Committee would take place Tuesday, the 17th November, 2015, at 4 pm in the Tucker Room.

E. Town Manager Report

Town Manager, Pat Finnigan, thanked all of the volunteers and staff who helped make the Nov 3rd Election Day go very smoothly. She said that in the future there could be more on the ballot to help clarify the issues before voters.

The Manager then showed everyone the "Award of Excellence" for the Annual Town Report which the Town had received. She said the Annual Report is a group effort, but the credit for this award goes to the Town Manager's Assistant, Janice Esancy for the wonderful job she does producing the Town's Annual Report.

Ms. Finnigan spoke of the live performance of the Nutcracker by the Atlantic Ballet Company that will take place at the Opera House during Christmas by the Sea, and the Pecha Kucha that will take place in the Opera House next weekend.

G. Licenses (Public Hearings)

1. Consideration of application of Brian Hill d/b/a Francine's Bistro at 55 Chestnut Street for renewal of a Class I Restaurant Malt, Spirituous, and Vinous Liquor License *John French made a motion to approve the renewal of a Class I Restaurant Malt, Spirituous, and Vinous Liquor License for Francine's Bistro at 55 Chestnut Street. Martin Cates seconded this and the motion passed 5-0.*

2. Consideration of application of Stuart Smith, d/b/a Bay View Street Inn at 16 Bay View Street for a Class I Hotel Malt, Spirituous, and Vinous Liquor License and Hotel Mini- bar. *John French made the motion to approve the Class I Hotel Malt, Spirituous, and Vinous Liquor License and Hotel Mini-bar for Bay View Street Inn at 16 Bay View Street. Martin Cates seconded this and the motion passed 5-0.*

H. New Business

1. Consideration of applications from Stuart Smith, d/b/a Bay View Street Inn, LLC at 16 Bay View Street for a victualers and lodging license.

John French made the motion to approve the applications from Stuart Smith, d/b/a Bay View Street Inn, LLC at 16 Bay View Street for a victualers and lodging license. Martin Cates seconded this motion, and it carried 5-0.

2. Consideration of abatements for prior year real estate and personal property accounts.

The Town Manager said these were not finalized and asked that these be tabled.

3. Approval of sale of Wastewater Department truck to MSAD 28.

John French made a motion to approve the sale of the 2006 GMC pick-up truck with plow to MSAD 28 in the amount of \$13,500. James Heard seconded the motion, and it passed 5-0.

4. Review of bids to purchase Town-owned property (Belfast Ave).

John French made a motion to accept the highest bid of \$5,000.00 made by the Laite Family. Leonard Lookner seconded this and the motion carried 5-0.

5. Request State action regarding a logging operation occurring on Hosmer Pond Road.

Martin Cates made the motion to send a letter to the Department of Environmental protection (DEP), Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry (DACF), Maine Department of Transportation (MDOT) and to the legislative delegation to work with the Town to enforce applicable laws and regulations, and to require the property owner to take necessary corrective action. John French seconded this and the motion carried 5-0.

Adjourn

James Heard made a motion to adjourn as the Select Board and to convene as the Board of Assessors. John French seconded this and the motion passed 5-0.

HARBOR FEES PAYMENT SCHEDULE

10/18/2012

FLOATS AND MOORINGS:

No later than March 1st of each year, the Harbor Clerk or duly appointed agent of the Harbor Clerk shall send a written notice (invoice) to holders of mooring and float sites, for the fees due. The invoice will be due and payable by April 1st of that year.

In the event that a person to whom an invoice has been sent, as set forth above, fails to respond on or before April 1st of that year, then on April 2nd the Harbor Clerk or the designated agent of the Harbor Clerk shall send a second written notice (invoice) by certified mail with return receipt requested, mailed to the last known address of the mooring or float site holder. This invoice must be received by the Harbor Clerk no later than May 1st of that year, accompanied by the appropriate paperwork and fees due plus a late fee.

In the event that the person to whom the certified letter has been sent, as set forth above, fails to respond with the appropriate paperwork and fees by May 1st the mooring or float site will be reassigned.

DAYSAILERS:

Daysailer fees which will be invoice by March 1st of each year shall be paid as follows: one-half by April 1st balance due by August 1st. Non-payment after written notice shall be cause for loss of privilege immediately or the following season at the discretion of the town.

WINDJAMMERS:

Windjammer fees which will be invoiced by March 1st of each year shall be paid as follows: one-half by April 1st balance due by August 1st. Non-payment after written notice shall be cause for loss of berthing privileges immediately or the following season at the discretion of the town.

Failure to sign final leases/licenses (to be delivered by April 1st) within 30 day of receipt shall be cause for loss of privilege immediately, or assessment of 20% late fee penalty at the discretion of the town.

SEASONAL BERTHING (DAYSAILERS ONLY)

Seasonal berthing fees shall be due and payable by April 1st. Nonpayment shall be cause for loss of privilege immediately, or the following season at the discretion of the town.

PRIVATE BERTHING/OVERNIGHT DOCKAGE

Fees are payable prior to actual use, or at the Harbormaster's discretion.

CAMDEN HARBOR WAITING LIST

No later than January 1st of each year, renewal applications (invoice) will be sent to all persons on the waiting lists the previous year. Renewal application and fee due must be received by the Harbor Clerk no later than January 31st

In the event that a person to whom a renewal application has been sent fails to respond by January 31st, then on February 1st a second notice will be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested. Payment of this invoice with a late fee must be received by the Harbor Clerk no later than March 1st, or that person's name will be removed from the waiting list.

DAYSAILER APPLICATIONS/FISHERMEN FLOAT APPLICATIONS

Daysailer applications and \$100.00 application fee shall be due by November 15th of each year.

Fisherman Float applications and \$25.00 application fee shall be due by November 15th of each year.

Application fees paid will be refundable to those who have been denied a permit by the Select Board. Application fees paid will be applied to permit fees for those permits which have been granted by the Select Board. The balance due for approved permits will be invoiced by March 1st of each year. Balances for permit fees will be due no later than April 1st of that year.

FEES AND LATE PAYMENT

Non-payment of fees shall result in the exclusion of the user, who has failed to pay that fee, from the harbor facility for which payment was required.

DAYSAILER LICENSE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the **TOWN OF CAMDEN**, a municipality located in Knox County, State of Maine, hereinafter referred to as "Camden," and, **RAMIRO & NICOLE DE ACEVEDO RAMOS OF CAMDEN, ME**, Knox County, State of ME, which operates the vessel **SURPRISE**, hereinafter referred to as "Licensee."

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Subject to the terms of this Agreement, Camden grants to the Licensee a license to use the Daysailer Float (hereinafter referred as the "Float") adjacent to the Public Landing in accordance with Section III of Camden's Harbor and Waterways Ordinance. Said license to use the Float shall be in common with rights granted to other boat owners to use that Float. The aforementioned license to use the Float shall be only for the purpose of picking up and dropping off passengers in connection with the daysailer business of the Licensee, and only for the use by the vessel set forth above.
2. The term of this Agreement shall commence **January 1, 2016** and end on **December 31, 2016**.
3. The fee for this Agreement shall be Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500), as set by the Camden Select Board in accordance with the Harbor and Waterways Ordinance of the Town of Camden.
4. The Licensee shall comply with all Federal, State and Local regulations including, without limitation, the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Camden and the Harbor and Waterways Ordinance of the Town of Camden.
5. The Licensee further agrees to abide by the following rules and regulations which have been established by the Select Board:
 - A. The Licensee shall adhere to the master schedule of arrival and departure times, as established by the Harbormaster, for daysailers licensed by Camden. A copy of said master schedule shall be kept on file at the Town Office with the application of the daysailer licensed herein. The Harbormaster's master schedule from the year immediately prior shall take precedence in establishing any subsequent proposed schedule.
 - B. The Licensee and Town employees shall extend courtesy to members of the general public, Town employees, Licensees, and other boat captains and personnel at all times.

- C. The Licensee's vessel shall lie alongside the Float for no more than Fifteen (15) minutes at any one time without the permission of the Harbormaster. The Licensee shall minimize the vessel's time at the Float insofar, as possible to accommodate other vessels.
- D. The Licensee shall be permitted to place a ticket table, no larger than Sixteen (16) square feet, on the boardwalk along the Public Landing. Ticket tables shall be set up only during business hours. Ticket table staff shall not bring animals to work, or engage in any other activity that might create a public safety hazard. The location of said ticket table shall be determined by previous locations of existing tables and shall be assigned by the Harbormaster. Any subsequent table locations shall be determined by the Harbormaster.
- E. The Licensee shall be permitted one (1) sign, no larger than six (6) square feet, at the ticket table, subject to the condition that such sign is considered a "temporary sign" under the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Camden. No other signage for the Licensee is allowed on the Public Landing.
- F. The Licensee shall permit no verbal solicitation for passengers on the Public Landing. Nothing contained in this subparagraph shall prohibit the Licensee, its agents and employees, from discussing or promoting daysailing activities with prospective patrons. The only permitted item for sale shall be tickets.
- G. The Licensee shall prohibit any employee, supplier, contractor, or agent of the licensee, or any crew member of the daysailer vessel, from parking in the parking spaces at the Public Landing, with the exception of one parking space for one vehicle owned or used by the Licensee, or an employee of the Licensee. It is the intent of Camden to allow the Licensee to use one parking space at the Public Landing for a vehicle to be parked in that parking space during emergencies, for the storage of brochures and other supplies, to provide shelter for employees during inclement weather, and for no other purpose whatsoever. In accordance with Chapter VIII, Schedule 12 of the Parking Ordinance of the Town of Camden, this one parking space is available to the Licensee only during the time that the Licensee operates a vessel from the Town float in accordance with the Harbor and Waterways Ordinance and for the commercial purposes allowed by this license.

After the execution of this license, the Police Chief, upon receipt of a written request endorsed by the Harbormaster and the Parking Committee of the Town of Camden, shall issue one permit to the Licensee for permission to park in one parking space at the Public Landing. No vehicle owned, operated, or controlled by the Licensee or any employee of the Licensee shall be parked in a parking space on the Public Landing unless that permit is displayed on the dashboard of that vehicle.

Any violation of the provisions set forth in this subparagraph shall be a cause for termination of this License Agreement in accordance with the procedures set forth in Paragraph 14 of this Agreement.

6. The Licensee shall indemnify and hold harmless Camden and the agents and employees of Camden against all liability, including costs and attorney's fees, resulting from any injury, death or damage occurring on or near the licensed premises or arising out of the Licensee's operations pursuant to this License, and arising out of negligence or omissions of the Licensee, its agents, patrons and employees.
7. Upon termination or expiration of this Agreement, the Licensee shall cease operations from the Float.
8. The Licensee shall carry adequate worker's compensation insurance or some other insurance providing equivalent protection for claims arising out of injuries to employees of the Licensee, and shall further obtain public liability insurance for the Licensee in an amount not less than Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) for personal injury involving one person, Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) for personal injury involving more than one person in a single occurrence, and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for property damage. The Licensee shall maintain such policies in effect throughout the duration of any use by the Licensee of the Float pursuant to this License.

The Licensee shall, no later than **JUNE 15, 2016**, furnish Camden with certificates of insurance as evidence that those insurance policies are in effect. Those insurance policies shall state that each policy shall not be canceled except upon no less than ten (10) days written notice to Camden of such cancellation.

9. The Licensee shall, no later than **JUNE 15, 2016**, provide proof of payment of excise tax for the licensed vessel. Such excised tax payments shall be made in accordance with Title 36 M.R.S.A. 1504.
10. Every right or remedy given to Camden by this Agreement is cumulative and no right or remedy shall be exclusive of any other right or remedy provided by law. The exercise of one right or remedy by Camden shall not impair the right of Camden to exercise any other right or remedy.
11. The Licensee shall not, at any time or in any manner, either directly or indirectly assign or encumber this Agreement or any of its interest herein or license the use of any part of the licensed premises, without first obtaining the written consent of Camden.
12. The Licensee agrees that this Agreement is not a lease and that no interest or estate in real property or the improvements located on the Public Landing is created by this Agreement.

13. This Agreement supersedes any existing Agreement between the parties with reference to the Float. This License shall expire on **December 31, 2016**. Any further License of the Float for any subsequent year shall be determined in accordance with the Harbor and Waterways Ordinance of the Town of Camden, and shall be subject of separate negotiations following the expiration of this License. Camden specifically reserves the right:

- to elect to award no Licenses for use of the Float for any year subsequent to December 31, 2016;
- to elect to award no License to the Licensee herein for any year subsequent to December 31, 2016; and
- to elect to award a License to the Licensee herein, for a year subsequent to December 31, 2016, under terms and conditions which differ from the terms and conditions set forth in this License.

14. Failure of the Licensee to abide by the terms and provisions of this Daysailer Licensing Agreement within seventy-two (72) hours after receiving written notice of such violation from the Harbormaster, and an opportunity to cure the violation within that 72-hour time period, shall result in termination of this Agreement by Camden.

The Town of Camden will receive sealed bids for a "**2016 GMC/CHEVROLET 2500HD**" in accordance with the NOTICE AND INFORMATION TO BIDDERS, BID SPECIFICATIONS and BID FORM. All of the bid documents are a material part of this NOTICE and are incorporated by reference into this NOTICE.

The Select Board shall make an award of the contract by considering, among other things, the lowest price for a proposal meeting the bid specifications. The Town of Camden reserves the right to waive any formalities; to reject any or all bids, or to accept any bid it considers to be in the best interest of the Town after considering quality, function, service, and initial cost, without obligation to consider price only. The Town's decision in all cases will be final. Tabulation will be mailed to vendors upon request.

If a bidder finds discrepancies in, or omissions from the Project documents, or is in doubt as to the meaning of the Project documents, the bidder shall, at once, notify the Town Manager, in writing; and upon receipt of such notification, the Town Manager shall send additional written clarification concerning the issues raised in the NOTICE to all prospective bidders.

Deviations from the Contract Documents: All deviations from the contract documents must be noted in detail by the bidder, in writing, at the time of submittal of the formal bid. Bidders are expressly informed that any material deviation from the contract documents may be a basis for rejection of the proposal by the Select Board at the time that the Board considers an award of the contract.

Prices must be firm for at least sixty (60) days.

At the time of the opening of proposals, each bidder shall be presumed to have read and be thoroughly familiar with the specifications in this BID NOTICE and all enclosures. The failure or omission of any bidder to receive or examine any form, instrument, or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation in respect to the proposal submitted. Any bidder to whom a contract is awarded shall be responsible for observing applicable standards for fair employment practices and work safety.

For purposes of this BID NOTICE and all Project documents, the term "bidder" shall mean any person, company or organization submitting a Proposal pursuant to this NOTICE and the term "bid" shall mean a Proposal submitted by a bidder.

Bids for the Wastewater Department new truck were received from O'Connor GMC and Quirk Chevrolet. Quirk was the low bidder with a bid of \$34,298, and O'Connor was close behind with a bid of \$34,300.

Although Quirk Chevrolet was the low bidder, they did not meet the bid specification for battery size as they quoted a smaller battery. Given O'Connor's bid was only \$2 higher than Quirk's bid, and the extra cost of the larger battery would exceed \$2, it is recommended the O'Connor bid be accepted.

\$30,000 was budgeted for the new truck purchase. The school district has agreed to buy the plant's 2006 pickup for the NADA book price of \$13,425. Therefore, the net cost of the new truck purchase will be \$20,875 which is \$9,125 below budget.




Biography for Barbara Veilleux
