NOTICE AND INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

The Town of Camden will receive sealed bids for a “**Sewer Collection System Pipe Repair**” in accordance with the NOTICE AND INFORMATION TO BIDDERS, BID SPECIFICATIONS and BID FORM. All of the bid documents are a material part of this NOTICE and are incorporated by reference into this NOTICE.

The Select Board shall make an award of the contract by considering, among other things, the lowest price for a proposal meeting the bid specifications. The Town of Camden reserves the right to waive any formalities; to reject any or all bids, or to accept any bid it considers to be in the best interest of the Town after considering quality, function, service, and initial cost, without obligation to consider price only. The Town's decision in all cases will be final. Tabulation will be mailed to vendors upon request.

If a bidder finds discrepancies in, or omissions from the Project documents, or is in doubt as to the meaning of the Project documents, the bidder shall, at once, notify the Town Manager, in writing; and upon receipt of such notification, the Town Manager shall send additional written clarification concerning the issues raised in the NOTICE to all prospective bidders.

Deviations from the Contract Documents: All deviations from the contract documents must be noted in detail by the bidder, in writing, at the time of submittal of the formal bid. Bidders are expressly informed that any material deviation from the contract documents may be a basis for rejection of the proposal by the Select Board at the time that the Board considers an award of the contract.

Prices must be firm for at least sixty (60) days.

At the time of the opening of proposals, each bidder shall be presumed to have read and be thoroughly familiar with the specifications in this BID NOTICE and all enclosures. The failure or omission of any bidder to receive or examine any form, instrument, or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation in respect to the proposal submitted. Any bidder to whom a contract is awarded shall be responsible for observing applicable standards for fair employment practices and work safety.

For purposes of this BID NOTICE and all Project documents, the term "bidder" shall mean any person, company or organization submitting a Proposal pursuant to this NOTICE and the term "bid" shall mean a Proposal submitted by a bidder.

Bids shall be placed in a sealed envelope marked "**Sewer Collection System Pipe Repair**" and received in the Office of the Camden Town Manager, P.O. Box 1207, 29 Elm Street, Camden, Maine 04843 on or before **noon, Friday, September 23, 2016. (No FAX bids will be accepted)** at which time all bids will be opened and read aloud. Bidders are invited to attend. **No proposal shall be accepted in the event that the envelope containing the proposal is not correctly marked as identified in the preceding sentence and sealed.** Prior to an award of the contract, no town official has been authorized to make any oral modifications or changes in the terms and specifications of this NOTICE.

Sewer Collection System Pipe Repair Camden, Maine

Scope of work: Repair sewer pipe on Bay View and Mechanic Street in Camden Maine.

Bay View Street Repair

Replace approximately 39 feet of six inch ABS truss pipe with six inch PVC SDR 35 pipe in accordance with Camden Wastewater Department Sewer Use Ordinance and construction standards.

The existing ABS truss pipe is approximately five feet below grade. It will be necessary to reconnect one sewer lateral and one Fernco fitting will be needed to join the new PVC pipe to the remaining ABS truss pipe. The current pipe termination will be removed, therefore a six inch PVC cap shall also be installed.

The Bidder shall pave the project area with hot mix asphalt. Existing asphalt around patch shall be saw cut and asphalt shall be installed in two lifts, the first lift will be 2 inches of 19 mm base and the second 1 ½ inches of 12.5 mm surface.

The Bidder shall remove all waste materials from the construction site and dispose of in accordance with all local, state and federal regulations.

Bay View Street is a narrow street, therefore the Bidder must provide all safety equipment and personnel to protect the public from injury and, at times shut down a section of the street as necessary while moving materials by dump truck.

Bidder shall work with the Wastewater Department to coordinate timing of this construction project to help minimize impact to businesses and residents on Bay View Street.

Mechanic Street Repair

Replace approximately eighteen feet of eight inch clay pipe with eight inch PVC SDR 35 pipe in accordance with Camden Wastewater Department Sewer Use Ordinance and construction standards.

The existing clay pipe is approximately five feet six inches below grade. No sewer laterals will need to be reconnected. Two Fernco fittings will be needed to join the new PVC pipe to the remaining clay pipe. Two inches rigid foam insulation shall be installed under the pipe in the area of the transecting storm drain.

The Bidder shall pave the project area with hot mix asphalt. Existing asphalt around patch shall be saw cut and asphalt shall be installed in two lifts, the first lift will be 2 inches of 19 mm base and the second 1 ½ inches of 12.5 mm surface.


The Bidder shall remove all waste materials from the construction site and dispose of in accordance with all local, state and federal regulations.

The Bidder must provide all safety equipment and personnel to protect the public from injury and, at times safely reduce traffic to one lane as needed while moving materials by truck.

Bidder shall work with the Wastewater Department to coordinate timing of this construction project to help minimize impact to businesses and residents on Mechanic Street.
