GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Camden, required by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Washington Street Conference Room located on Washington Street in said Town on Thursday, September 26, 2013 at 6:30 p.m. to vote on Articles 1 and 2 at which time the meeting will adjourn. **There will be a Board of Assessors meeting immediately following to approve the Tax Commitment.**

ARTICLE 1

To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2

Shall the Town vote to respond to a reduction in state-municipal revenue sharing by appropriating up to \$135,000 from the Town's undesignated fund balance to be applied to reduce the total property tax commitment for the 2013-2014 fiscal year?

Information Note: The State of Maine has reduced the amount of municipal revenue sharing for the 2013-2014 fiscal year. This transfer from the undesignated fund balance (surplus) would serve to limit an increase in the total tax commitment caused by the reduction in revenue sharing.

The Select Board gives notice that the Registrar of Voters will be in session at the Camden Town Office for the purpose of accepting and correcting the voting list during regular business hours Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. and at the Special Town Meeting on Thursday, September 26, 2013 from 6:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.

You must be a Camden registered voter to vote in any election.


