

1 **4. COORDINATOR’S REPORT:**

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3 Ms. Freedman-White provided an up-date on the status of all chapters. Mr. Sargent reminded
4 the Committee how far they have fallen behind schedule because of the time consumed by the Fox
5 Hill review. He asked members if they would be willing to meet one extra day a month to work only
6 on the Comprehensive Plan. Members agreed that would be more productive than starting Comp Plan
7 meetings late in the evening. The first workshop will be held February 27 –place to be determined.
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9 She also noted that she is having problems getting response back from chapter participants.
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11 **5. CHAIRMAN’S REPORT:**

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13 Part of the Select Board’s discussion during their hearing on the Fox Hill amendment had to do
14 with the need to review the Zoning Ordinance district by district to determine if there is a need for
15 changes that reflect today’s reality. Mr. Sargent recommends that members are assigned districts to
16 review and develop recommendations for discussion. The Board could hold a facilitated public
17 meeting to gather opinions on what is and is not working, and ask what changes people want to see.
18 He asked members to think about this approach so they can discuss this issue at length on the 27th.
