

49 regional transportation project; and to include provisions for bicycles and pedestrians in all regional
50 transportation planning. Some of the language recommended comes directly from the Pathways
51 Master Plan, and the Scotts will supply that language. Mr. Scott asked if there would be specific
52 references to their Master Plan within the Comp Plan, and added that that the more specific the
53 references within the Comp Plan are with regard to specific Pathways Master Plan goals, the more
54 weight the Comp Plan connection carries in grant applications.

56 **9: CPC REVIEW:**

57 **District Review: Village and Village Extension (V and VE): Richard Householder**
58

59 The drafts were just distributed so full review was deferred until the January 8 meeting. Mr.
60 Bernhard asked if Mr. Householder if he could add some discussion of the history and character of the
61 Districts and if he would include a discussion of the interface of the VE with the rural districts. He
62 understands that the purpose of describing these districts is to inform readers of the unique history and
63 characteristics of different parts of the area – if they are interested in moving here they will want to
64 know what the Town is like in those ways, not in the way described in Mr. Householder’s draft that
65 lists an inventory of uses.

67 Ms. Brosius-Scott asked if in recommending certain changes to these districts, the Committee
68 was laying out a road map for future zoning amendments. She recommended that in addition to
69 looking at making changes to what exists, the Committee also consider what it is they would like to
70 specifically preserve in each district. Mr. Bernhard suggested that the conversations the Committee
71 hopes to have with residents of each district will help direct the recommendations that will be put
72 forward in the Plan.

74 **10. SCHEDULE of REVIEW:**

75 The schedule was updated, and the meeting schedule reviewed: The Comprehensive Plan
76 Committee will meet on January 8 instead of 15. Planning Board will meet on the 15 and either the 22
77 or 29 depending upon the Snow Bowl Lodge submissions schedule.

79 There being no further business before the Committee they adjourned at 6:15pm to re-adjourn
80 as the Planning Board.
