**PROCEDURE**

No dinghies over 10' (TVL) will be permitted in the Town Dinghy Rack. Dinghies with a freeboard over 18" will not fit in the rack.

Whenever weather conditions warrant, dinghies must be removed from the rack and taken away by their owners to avoid damage to Town property. There will be no motors allowed stored on the rack.

***This permit*** will allow the holder to store a 10' or shorter dinghy in the Steamboat Landing Dinghy Rack. Besides two hour transient use at the Town Dinghy Dock, this permit does not give the holder the privilege to use the Town Floats as a berth.

All dinghies must be removed from the Town Rack by November 15<sup>th</sup>. After that date, the Town will remove remaining dinghies, transport them to the public works yard and charge a fee of \$100.00 to cover the cost of removal. Permit stickers will be affixed to the port side of the transom.

Permit holders must follow all current vehicular parking regulations.

\*Total Vessel Length (TVL): The extreme length of vessel measured to include any and all extensions or overhangs from the hull's stem or stern, such as bowsprits, boomkins, rudder posts, booms, davits, outboard motors in normal operating position, swim platforms or any other extensions from the hull.
