

# NOTICE

**Camden beaches are not tested for bacteria after Labor Day.**

High bacteria levels may result from rainfall and storm water runoff, wildlife contamination and poor sanitary beach practices. Exposure to high bacteria levels may cause water-related illnesses which could include nausea, diarrhea, stomach cramps, chills and fever. Skin rashes and infections of the eyes, ears, nose and throat may also occur.

If you have water-related illness symptoms, notify your physician or seek treatment. If you have reason to believe your symptoms were due to contaminated swimming water at any Town beach, please call the Town of Camden Health Officer at 236-3353.
